## THE UNIVERSITY CHARTER

The origins of Southern Illinois University Carbondale date to "An Act to Establish and Maintain the Southern Illinois Normal University" approved by the Illinois General Assembly on March 9, 1869.

The act defined the new university's purpose as "to qualify teachers for the common schools of this state by imparting instruction in the art of teaching in all branches of study which pertain to a common school education in the elements of the natural sciences including agricultural chemistry, animal and vegetable physiology, in the fundamental laws of the United States and of the State of Illinois in regard to the rights and duties of citizens and such other studies as the board of education may from time to time prescribe."

It included provisions for appointment of a Board of Trustees. One of the board's first orders of business under the act would be to "advertise for proposals from localities desiring to secure the location of said Normal University." The act required the board to "locate the institution at such point, as shall, all things considered, offer the most advantageous conditions. The land shall be selected south of the Railroad, or within six miles north of said road,

passing from St. Louis to Terre Haute known as the Alton and Terre Haute railroad, with a view of obtaining a good supply of water and other conveniences for the use of the institution."

The act defines how buildings would be constructed, as well as procedures for selecting students. It assigned a budget of \$75,000 for construction of buildings and for furnishings.

The University Charter currently displayed in Anthony Hall was bound by alumna Wendy Hale Davis, a bookbinder, artist and musician in Austin, Texas.

# CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a decorated staff carried in the commencement procession, is a symbol within a symbol. It denotes the right of the university administration to confer degrees on its graduates.

The presence of a mace in ceremonial processions dates to the Middle Ages. The earliest maces were practical items, carried by sergeants-at-arms as part of the royal bodyguards' means of protecting the king and as a symbol of his authority. In time, the mace was adapted to civic use and represented leadership. No longer a weapon, the mace became a work of art, decorated with precious metals and often bearing the seal of the city or university it represented.

Universities began incorporating a mace into their ceremonies as early as the 15th century. In the United States, most universities continue the tradition and incorporate a ceremonial mace into commencement exercises.

At SIU, the mace is very much a product of the university as well as representative of it. Professor Richard Smith, blacksmith and faculty member in the School of Art and Design, was commissioned to create a mace to debut in 2013. He turned to professor emeritus Richard Mawdsley, silversmith, to complete the project. He also enlisted the assistance of alumna Erin Dixon; assistant professor Sun Kyoung Kim; graduate student Patrick Quinn; and undergraduate students Timothy Schaeffer and Daniel Widolff – all from the School of Art and Design.

The mace, constructed of Damascus steel and silver, is 42 inches tall and 1¼ inches wide at its widest point. Design elements incorporate architectural references to Old Main – a campus building when SIU was the brand-new Southern Illinois Normal University, a teachers college, in 1874. Though Old Main was destroyed by fire in 1969, it holds a special place in the collective memory of the university.

# ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia worn by faculty during commencement is based on attire from 12th- and 13th-century universities. Academic dress and accoutrements of this type have been used in the United States since colonial times. To maintain tradition and the conformity of academic symbols, little has changed in the symbolism of pattern and color since the Middle Ages. In 1895 an intercollegiate commission in the United States adopted a standardized code for the use of academic gowns, hoods and caps, which included regulating the cut, style and materials of gowns. In addition, colors, which were to represent the different fields of learning, were prescribed. Over the years, only minor revisions have been made to the code, which is followed by the majority of colleges and universities in America, including Southern Illinois University Carbondale.

## GOWNS

The bachelor's gown is a comparatively simple style that falls in straight lines from an elaborate yoke and has pointed sleeves. The master's gown is similar to the bachelor's except for its peculiar arrangement of the long sleeves with square ends that hang below the elbow. The doctor's gown is elaborate, full-cut and flowing, and is distinguished by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three velvet bars on the bell-shaped sleeves.

## STOLE OF GRATITUDE

Southern Illinois University Carbondale has incorporated the custom of the Stole of Gratitude since the 2012 commencement ceremony. This custom offers an opportunity for graduates to pay thanks to anyone who has helped them attend or excel in college. This stole is worn during the commencement ceremony or at another occasion where a presentation is appropriate. After the ceremony, the new graduate presents the Stole of Gratitude to someone who provided extraordinary help or support.



# HOODS, CAPS, AND TASSELS

Historically, the academic hood was literally a garment to protect the wearer from foul weather. Today, it is the identifying symbol of the degree, and the length indicates which degree it represents: 3 1/2 feet for the master's and 4 feet for the doctoral degree. Hoods are lined with the official color of the college or university conferring the degree, and the color of trimming identifies the major field of learning.

The mortarboard is the cap generally worn with academic regalia. A long tassel is fastened to the middle point on the top of the cap. The tassel is usually the color appropriate to the subject. There is no general rule on the position of the tassel on the mortarboard. However, numerous institutions have adopted a practice of requiring candidates for degrees to wear the tassels on the right front side before degrees are conferred, and to shift them to the left side when the degrees are awarded to them.

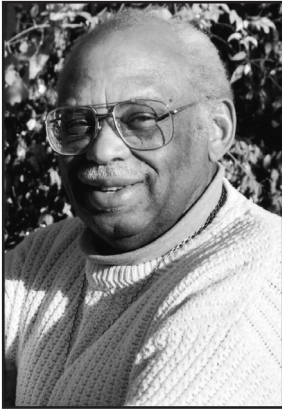

# HONORARY DEGREE

## REGINALD PETTY



**Reginald Edwin Petty**, a trailblazer in civil rights, education, and international development, is a 1956 and 1963 graduate of Southern Illinois University Carbondale, earning bachelor's and master's degrees in sociology and secondary education. Born during the era of segregation, he often recalls, "I was conceived in East Saint Louis, Illinois, but was born in Saint Louis, Missouri," due to black mothers being denied access to hospitals in his hometown. This injustice would spark a lifetime of advocacy for social equity and human dignity.

Petty's activism began in the 1960s, when he joined the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC), working alongside icons like John Lewis and Dick Gregory. He was arrested more than 30 times while registering black voters in the Deep South – evidence of his deep commitment to justice and civil rights.

In 1966, Petty's impact grew global when he was recruited by Sargent Shriver to join the Peace Corps. He became one of its first African American Country Directors, serving in the Republic of Upper Volta (now Burkina Faso), Swaziland, Kenya, and the Seychelles. His work in these newly independent nations helped establish sustainable development, education programs, and cross-cultural understanding.

He held numerous U.S. Presidential appointments, including Executive Director of the National Advisory Council on Vocational Education (N.A.C.V.E.), Regional Director of VISTA (Region II – New York, New Jersey, Virgin Islands), Executive Director of the African Development Foundation, and Director of the National Research Center. As Director of Research for both N.A.C.V.E. and Westinghouse Learning Corporation, he published a national vocational education study that spanned three years of data.

A passionate educator and researcher, Petty's achievements underscore SIU's distinction as an R1 research university. He has continued sharing his knowledge with schools and communities, often through his extensive collection of African art. These cultural works have been featured at SIU's University Museum in 2002 and 2020, serving as educational tools that bridge African and African American heritage.

Upon returning to East St. Louis, he focused on local revitalization – leading the Local Neighborhood Opportunity program and preserving the city's history. He co-authored *Legendary East St. Louisans*, honoring hometown heroes like Miles Davis and Jackie Joyner-Kersey, and even rescued thousands of books from a closed library to safeguard access to knowledge for future generations. He is the subject of the book *The Pandemic Prophet – The Legacy of Reginald E. Petty*, highlighting his life's work for civil rights.

At age 89, Petty still advocates for justice. At a 2020 Black Lives Matter rally, he inspired young activists from his wheelchair with a megaphone in hand, reminding them that the fight for justice is a relay – and the baton must be passed. In 2024, he led a re-enactment of the 1917 NAACP Silent Protest Parade with local citizens on the 107th anniversary of the event, as the founder of the East St. Louis Historical Society.

He is married to renowned multidisciplinary artist Edna Patterson-Petty, and is the proud father of Anthony, Joel, and Amina Petty, and grandfather to several beloved grandchildren. Reginald Petty's legacy is one of relentless service, intellectual excellence, and transformational leadership, rooted in his alma mater and radiating across continents.

Reginald Petty will receive his Honorary Degree in the 1 p.m. ceremony.



# DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

## EDWARD BENYAS

**Edward Benyas** has spent his life bringing music to life – with a baton, a reed, and a relentless dedication to community and education. As a conductor, oboist, professor, and arts leader, his career spans continents and disciplines, but his deepest impact has been right here in Southern Illinois.

Benyas served as Professor of Oboe and Conducting at Southern Illinois University Carbondale from 1994 to 2023, shaping generations of musicians through nearly three decades of mentorship and performance. He is now Professor Emeritus and continues to serve as Music Director of the Southern Illinois Symphony Orchestra and the Skokie Valley Symphony. Beyond Carbondale, he leads the New Chicago Chamber Orchestra, the Cascade Symphony, and serves as Principal Conductor of Winter Opera St. Louis and Musica Le Mans in France.



Perhaps most notably, Benyas is the founder and Artistic Director of the Southern Illinois Music Festival (SIFest), a two-week annual event that presents more than three dozen concerts featuring classical music, opera, ballet, and jazz across the region. This festival has elevated the cultural landscape of Southern Illinois, bringing world-class artistry to underserved audiences. It has been honored as a “Midwest Travel Treasure” by AAA Magazine and named one of the 24 best summer events across eight states by the Chicago Tribune.

Benyas’s conducting repertoire spans nearly 400 works, including numerous world premieres and full-length opera and ballet productions. Following his performance of *The Magic Flute*, *Opera Wire* praised his work, noting that he “indeed worked some ‘magic’ in the pit,” producing a performance of “very high order throughout.” His clear and inspiring leadership has earned accolades from peers, including musicians of the Philadelphia Orchestra.

He is also a sought-after performer, having played oboe and English horn with the Chicago Symphony under Daniel Barenboim, the *Lyric Opera* under Zubin Mehta, and the Milwaukee and Grant Park Symphonies. His artistry has been featured at the Spoleto and Banff festivals, with the Ravinia Festival Orchestra, and as principal oboe of the Des Moines Metro Opera. He also toured nationally as part of Andrea Bocelli’s orchestra.

Over the years, Benyas has earned a constellation of honors: Illinois Council of Orchestras’ “Conductor of the Year” (2005), Carbondale Chamber of Commerce’s inaugural “Keeping the Arts in Business” award (2007), Southern Business Journal’s “Leader Among Us” (2012), Legacy Award from Carbondale Community Arts (2015), David Kenney Award from the Carbondale Lions Club (2017), and SIU College of Liberal Arts Outstanding Scholar (2018).

A student of legends such as Ray Still and Charles Bruck, Benyas holds graduate degrees from Northwestern University in orchestral conducting and oboe performance, as well as both a bachelor’s and Juris Doctor degree from the University of Michigan. He is a licensed attorney in Illinois and has served on both the Jackson County Board and the Carbondale Elementary School District Board of Education.

Edward Benyas’s journey is a symphony of public service, artistic excellence, and educational impact – resonating far beyond the concert hall and into the heart of every community he’s touched.

Edward Benyas will receive his Distinguished Service Award in the 9 a.m. ceremony.

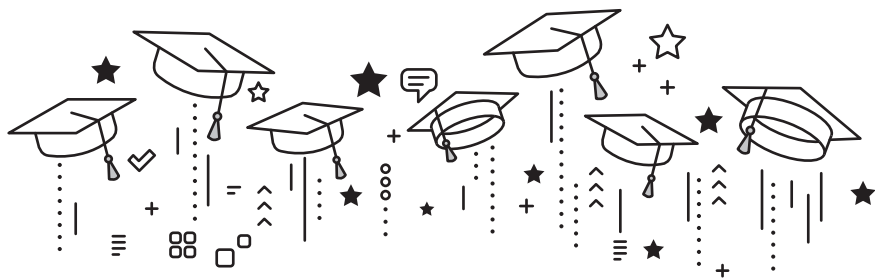

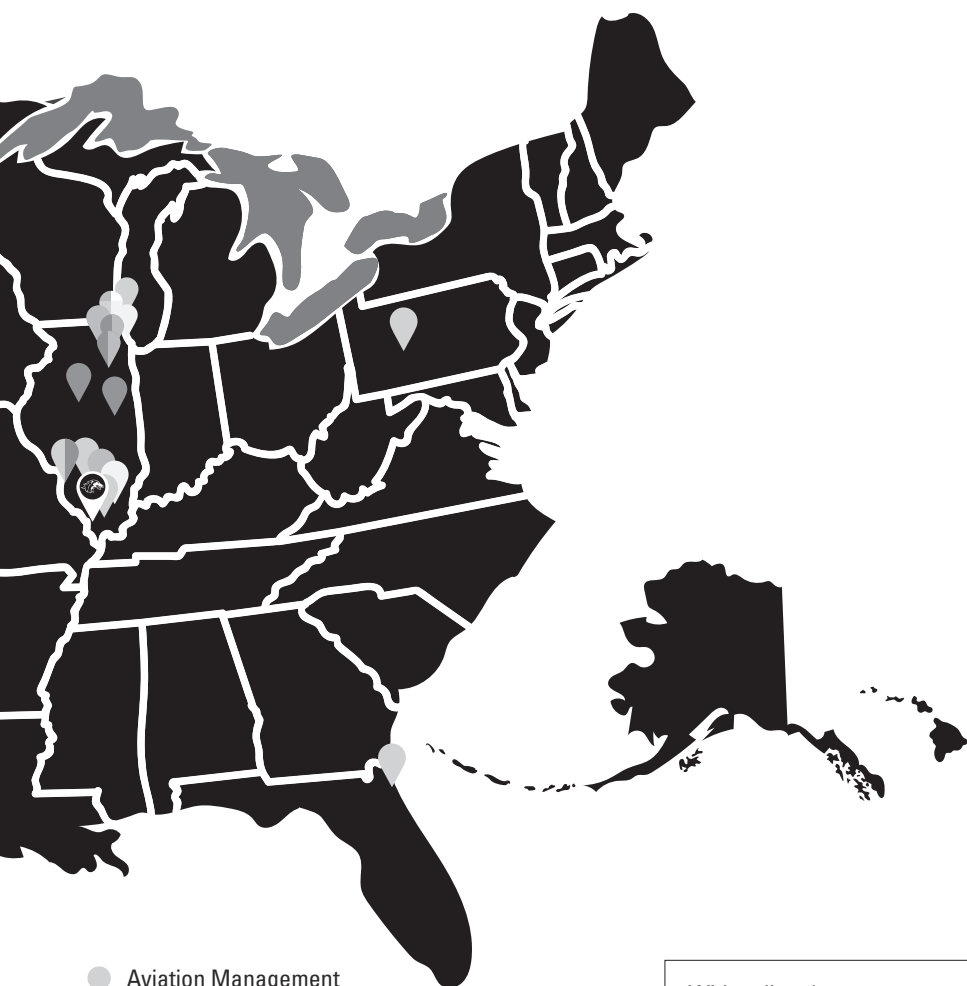
