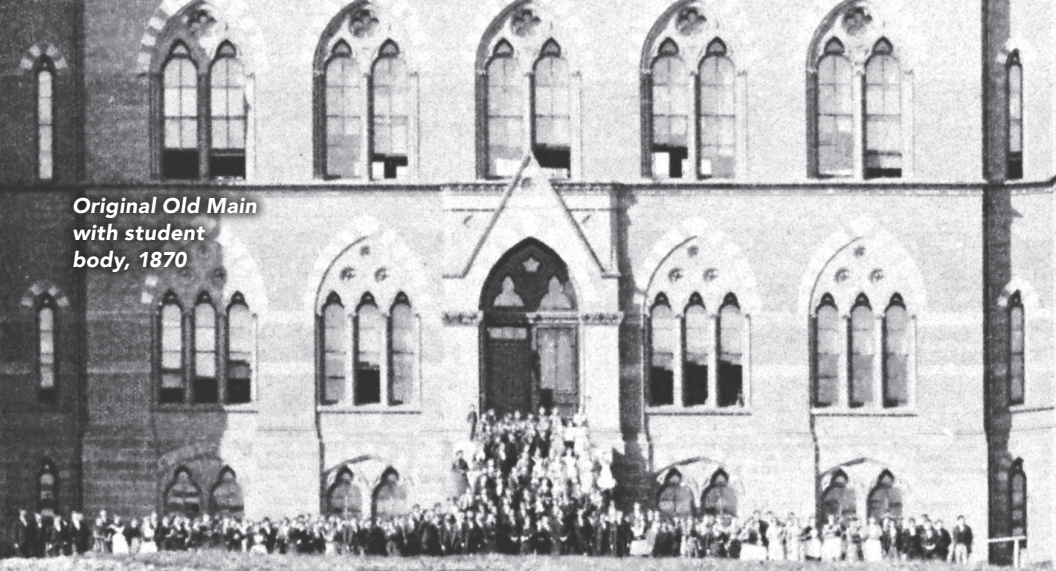

THE UNIVERSITY CHARTER

The origins of Southern Illinois University Carbondale date to "An Act to Establish and Maintain the Southern Illinois Normal University" approved by the Illinois General Assembly on March 9, 1869.

The act defined the new university's purpose as "to qualify teachers for the common schools of this state by imparting instruction in the art of teaching in all branches of study which pertain to a common school education in the elements of the natural sciences including agricultural chemistry, animal and vegetable physiology, in the fundamental laws of the United States and of the State of Illinois in regard to the rights and duties of citizens and such other studies as the board of education may from time to time prescribe."

It included provisions for appointment of a Board of Trustees. One of the board's first orders of business under the act would be to "advertise for proposals from localities desiring to secure the location of said Normal University." The act required the board to "locate the institution at such point, as shall, all things considered, offer the most advantageous conditions. The land shall be selected south of the Railroad, or within six miles north of said road,

passing from St. Louis to Terre Haute known as the Alton and Terre Haute railroad, with a view of obtaining a good supply of water and other conveniences for the use of the institution."

The act defines how buildings would be constructed, as well as procedures for selecting students. It assigned a budget of \$75,000 for construction of buildings and for furnishings.

The University Charter currently displayed in Anthony Hall was bound by alumna Wendy Hale Davis, a bookbinder, artist and musician in Austin, Texas.

The inspirational message on the next page is displayed, along with the charter, during commencement exercises. This message was written by the late Charles D. Tenney, SIU professor and Distinguished Service Award recipient. The message is displayed on the south wall of Morris Library's Hall of Presidents and Chancellors and has a special place in the hearts of our students and alumni.

CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, a decorated staff carried in the commencement procession, is a symbol within a symbol. It denotes the right of the university administration to confer degrees on its graduates.

The presence of a mace in ceremonial processions dates to the Middle Ages. The earliest maces were practical items, carried by sergeants-at-arms as part of the royal bodyguards' means of protecting the king and as a symbol of his authority. In time, the mace was adapted to civic use and represented leadership. No longer a weapon, the mace became a work of art, decorated with precious metals and often bearing the seal of the city or university it represented.

Universities began incorporating a mace into their ceremonies as early as the 15th century. In the United States, most universities continue the tradition and incorporate a ceremonial mace into commencement exercises.

At SIU, the mace is very much a product of the university as well as representative of it. Professor Richard Smith, blacksmith and faculty member in the School of Art and Design, was commissioned to create a mace to debut in 2013. He turned to professor emeritus Richard Mawdsley, silversmith, to complete the project. He also enlisted the assistance of alumna Erin Dixon; assistant professor Sun Kyoung Kim; graduate student Patrick Quinn; and undergraduate students Timothy Schaeffer and Daniel Widolff – all from the School of Art and Design.

The mace, constructed of Damascus steel and silver, is 42 inches tall and 1¼ inches wide at its widest point. Design elements incorporate architectural references to Old Main – a campus building when SIU was the brand-new Southern Illinois Normal University, a teachers college, in 1874. Though Old Main was destroyed by fire in 1969, it holds a special place in the collective memory of the university.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia worn by faculty during commencement is based on attire from 12th- and 13th-century universities. Academic dress and accoutrements of this type have been used in the United States since colonial times. To maintain tradition and the conformity of academic symbols, little has changed in the symbolism of pattern and color since the Middle Ages. In 1895, an intercollegiate commission in the United States adopted a standardized code for the use of academic gowns, hoods and caps, which included regulating the cut, style and materials of gowns. In addition, colors, which were to represent the different fields of learning, were prescribed. Over the years, only minor revisions have been made to the code, which is followed by the majority of colleges and universities in America, including Southern Illinois University Carbondale.

GOWNS

The bachelor's gown is a comparatively simple style that falls in straight lines from an elaborate yoke and has pointed sleeves. The master's gown is similar to the bachelor's except for its peculiar arrangement of the long sleeves with square ends that hang below the elbow. The doctor's gown is elaborate, full-cut and flowing, and is distinguished by velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and by three velvet bars on the bell-shaped sleeves.

STOLE OF GRATITUDE

Southern Illinois University Carbondale has incorporated the custom of the Stole of Gratitude since the 2012 commencement ceremony. This custom offers an opportunity for graduates to pay thanks to anyone who has helped them attend or excel in college. This stole is worn during the commencement ceremony or at another occasion where a presentation is appropriate. After the ceremony, the new graduate presents the Stole of Gratitude to someone who provided extraordinary help or support.

HOODS, CAPS, AND TASSELS

Historically, the academic hood was literally a garment to protect the wearer from foul weather. Today, it is the identifying symbol of the degree, and the length indicates which degree it represents: 3^{1/2} feet for the master's and 4 feet for the doctoral degree. Hoods are lined with the official color of the college or university conferring the degree, and the color of trimming identifies the major field of learning.

The mortarboard is the cap generally worn with academic regalia. A long tassel is fastened to the middle point on the top of the cap. The tassel is usually the color appropriate to the subject. There is no general rule on the position of the tassel on the mortarboard. However, numerous institutions have adopted a practice of requiring candidates for degrees to wear the tassels on the right front side before degrees are conferred, and to shift them to the left side when the degrees are awarded to them.

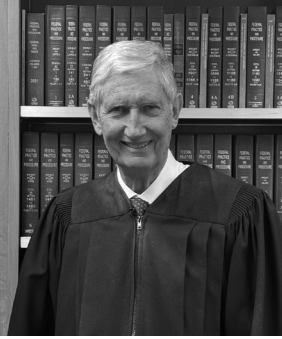

HONORARY DEGREE



THE HONORABLE J. PHIL GILBERT is a lifelong resident of Carbondale, Illinois, whose distinguished career reflects a deep and enduring commitment to justice, public service and Southern Illinois. A graduate of Carbondale Community High School, he earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Illinois and his Juris Doctor from Loyola University Chicago School of Law in 1974. He returned home to begin his legal career, joining his family's law practice and quickly establishing a reputation for integrity and dedication to his community.

Judge Gilbert's early career included service as Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Illinois and Assistant City Attorney for Carbondale. He went on to serve nearly a decade on the Illinois State Board of Elections, including terms as Chairman and Vice Chairman, contributing to election reform and governmental ethics efforts across the state. In 1988, he was appointed by the Illinois Supreme Court as a Circuit Judge in the First Judicial Circuit, where he presided over a broad range of civil and criminal matters.

In 1992, Judge Gilbert was appointed to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Illinois by President George H. W. Bush. He served as Chief Judge from 1993 to 2000, providing leadership during a period of growth and innovation within the court. Over more than three decades on the federal bench – including his continued service as Senior Judge since 2014 – he has earned widespread respect for his fairness, thoughtful decision-making and commitment to the rule of law. His influence extends nationally through service on committees of the Judicial Conference of the United States, including those focused on criminal law and judicial security.



Beyond the courtroom, Judge Gilbert has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to Southern Illinois University. Appointed to the SIU Board of Trustees in 2015 and serving as Chairman since 2019, he has played a critical role in guiding the university system with steady leadership and a strong connection to its mission.

Judge Gilbert's many honors – including the Silver Gavel Award, the SIU School of Law Founders' Medal, and the Distinguished Jurist Award from Loyola University – reflect a career defined by excellence and service. His lifelong dedication to his profession, his university and his community exemplifies the highest ideals of leadership and public trust.

Judge Gilbert and his wife, Gail, have two children: Jennifer Presley and her husband, J.W., and John Gilbert and his wife, Sarah. They are the proud grandparents of Will and Emmerson Presley.

HONORARY DEGREE



MICHAEL THEODORE

GLENN is a distinguished former professional athlete, educator, broadcaster and historian whose career reflects a lifelong commitment to leadership, service and education. A standout student-athlete, he earned national recognition as a two-time NCAA Academic All-American basketball player, including being named the top honoree in 1977 while competing at Southern Illinois University Carbondale.

Glenn went on to play in the National Basketball Association from 1977 to 1986, including time with the New York Knicks, where he distinguished himself not only on the court but also through his academic and professional pursuits. While competing at the highest level of professional basketball, he pursued graduate studies and gained experience working on Wall Street, demonstrating an early commitment to excellence beyond athletics.

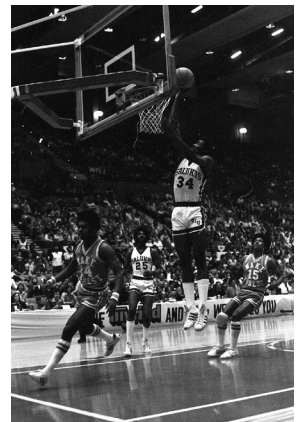
Following his playing career, Glenn built a multifaceted professional life spanning more than four decades. He spent 26 years as a sports broadcaster and 13 years teaching GED courses, helping students of all backgrounds achieve educational success. His dedication to mentorship and student development has remained a defining aspect of his work.

In 1980, Glenn founded the nation's first basketball camp for deaf athletes, a groundbreaking initiative that continues to serve young people today. His work with the camp was later featured in the award-winning film "Spirit of Love," in which he appeared as himself. Through this and other efforts, Glenn has consistently used sport as a platform for inclusion, empowerment and community impact.

Glenn is also an accomplished historian and author, curating more than 30 exhibits nationwide that explore themes including civil rights, African American history, women's rights and literacy through original documents and artifacts. He has authored five books, further extending his influence as an educator and thought leader.

His many honors – including the NBA's Walter B. Kennedy Citizenship Award, induction into the Missouri Valley Conference Hall of Fame and the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame, and recognition from numerous civic and educational organizations – reflect a career defined by service and achievement.

Michael Glenn's lifelong dedication to education, community engagement, and leadership exemplifies the highest ideals of perseverance, service, and public impact.

POSTHUMOUS DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD



CHERYL F. GREEN was a transformative leader in higher education whose career reflected a deep and enduring commitment to student success, equity and community engagement. A proud alumna of Southern Illinois University Carbondale, she earned both her master's degree and Ph.D. in counseling psychology from SIU, establishing a foundation for a career dedicated to expanding access and opportunity in higher education.

Throughout her career, Green championed academic enrichment initiatives and student success programs that supported first-generation and non-traditional students while improving retention and graduation rates. Her leadership

was marked by a strong focus on inclusive excellence and the belief that all students deserve the opportunity to thrive.

Green served as president of Governors State University, where she advanced institutional growth, strengthened community partnerships, and led strategic efforts to enhance student achievement. Prior to her presidency, she held numerous senior leadership roles, including Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs at the University of Wisconsin–Oshkosh, Interim Chancellor of the University of Wisconsin–Whitewater, and Assistant Vice President for Student Affairs at Tennessee State University.

Earlier in her career, Green dedicated many years to Chicago State University, where she held a variety of academic and administrative positions, including director and chair of the counseling department, inaugural dean of first-year students, acting associate director of career placement, and tenured associate professor of counseling. She also served as grievance officer for the University Professionals of Illinois Local 4100, representing faculty and staff across multiple public universities.

In addition to her leadership roles, Green demonstrated exceptional expertise in fiscal and institutional management, overseeing complex university budgets and contributing to successful grant development efforts that advanced institutional priorities. Her scholarly work focused on improving student achievement and expanding community-based health initiatives to better serve diverse populations.

Her commitment to service extended beyond the university, with leadership roles on numerous boards and advisory organizations nationwide. Her many honors – including recognition as one of Crain's Chicago Business' Notable Black Leaders and Executives and the Dolores C. Huerta Woman of Courage medallion – reflect her lasting impact.

Green's legacy is carried forward through her unwavering dedication to education, her passion for student success and her belief in the potential of all individuals. She is survived by her two children, who continue to honor her commitment to making a difference in the lives of others.

Cheryl F. Green will receive her Posthumous Distinguished Service Award in the 9 a.m. ceremony.

HONORARY DEGREE

JAMES JOSEPH MILLER is a distinguished leader in aviation, space and public service whose career reflects a sustained commitment to advancing complex technical systems and national priorities. He currently serves as senior program manager to the chief executive of General Atomics Global Corporation, where he leads the establishment of international offices across Europe, the Middle East and Asia in support of critical defense missions and global partnerships.



A three-degree alumnus of Southern Illinois University Carbondale, Miller earned an Associate in Applied Science in Aviation Flight, a Bachelor of Science in Aviation Management and a Master of Public Administration in Aviation Administration. His academic journey also included international study at Curtin University and research at Queensland University of Technology, reflecting an early commitment to global engagement in aviation and space systems.

Miller began his professional career at United Airlines World Headquarters, contributing to the modernization of flight operations and developing expertise in aviation communications, navigation and spectrum systems essential to safety and performance. He later entered federal service with the United States Department of Transportation, advising senior leadership on interagency spectrum and satellite navigation policy and representing the United States in international radiocommunication forums.

At NASA Headquarters, Miller served in senior leadership as deputy director in the Space Communications and Navigation Program. He also served as founding director of the National Space-Based Positioning, Navigation, and Timing Advisory Board, appointed by NASA, helping guide national policy and coordination in this critical field. He led multidisciplinary teams advancing positioning, navigation and timing capabilities across global space networks and served as head of the NASA delegation to the International Committee on Global Navigation Satellite Systems, strengthening international collaboration among satellite navigation providers and partner space agencies. His service also included work with the National Space Council, supporting alignment between national space priorities and industry leadership.

Miller retired from NASA in 2025 as the Firefly Blue Ghost mission he sponsored successfully deployed the first GPS receiver on the moon, marking a significant advancement in navigation capabilities beyond Earth's orbit.

He also holds a Master of International Policy and Practice in Space Policy from George Washington University and completed executive studies at Harvard Kennedy School. His many honors from NASA and the Institute of Navigation reflect a career defined by innovation, leadership and service.

James and his wife have three children and divide their time between Washington, D.C. and San Diego, California. His lifelong dedication to his profession and his field exemplifies the highest ideals of leadership and public impact.

Determined to pay his own way through college, he delayed enrollment to work and save before entering the Vocational Technical Institute at Southern Illinois University Carbondale. He earned an Associate of Arts degree in 1970, establishing an enduring connection to SIU.

While at SIU, Bartmes met his wife, Linda, beginning a partnership that has spanned more than five decades. After her graduation, he continued his education at the University of Illinois at Chicago, earning his bachelor's degree in 1973. He pursued graduate study in urban

planning, completing his coursework in 1975 and, while advancing his professional career, finishing his dissertation in 1986.

Bartmes spent more than four decades in investment banking, holding leadership roles with Halsey Stuart & Co., William Blair & Co., and Hutchinson, Shockey, Erley & Co. Throughout his career, he was recognized for his integrity, strategic insight and steady leadership, earning the trust of clients and colleagues alike.

In addition to his professional accomplishments, Bartmes has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to philanthropic leadership and civic engagement. His support of educational and community initiatives has had a meaningful and lasting impact, including significant contributions that have advanced student opportunity and program development at SIU.

His service extends across a wide range of organizations. He has served as a board member and chief investment officer for a major family foundation and has contributed his expertise to institutions including the Adler Planetarium, the Chicago Botanic Garden, Interfaith Chaplaincy Service and the Friends Committee on National Legislation in Washington, D.C.

Her service spans a wide range of programs and events, including the Southern Illinois Regional Science Fair, Math Field Day, Expanding Your Horizons and the Illinois Junior Academy of Science State Fair. Through her leadership and hands-on involvement, she has helped create meaningful opportunities for students to engage with science and mathematics while sustaining and strengthening key educational traditions at SIU.

Pericak-Spector's contributions also extend to professional and community service at the local, regional and state levels. She has held leadership roles within the Illinois Junior Academy of Science and other organizations dedicated to advancing STEM education, further amplifying the university's impact across Illinois and the surrounding region.

Kathleen Pericak-Spector's enduring dedication to service – particularly her extraordinary volunteer contributions following retirement – exemplifies the true spirit of distinguished service and reflects the highest ideals of commitment, generosity and public impact.
